On Monday, December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018 we are offering a **Free Community-based Memory Screening** in partnership with Toronto Memory Program.

The screening will be held at Angus Glen Community Centre - Meeting Room B, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Toronto Memory Program is looking to raise awareness about brain health and cognitive aging by running free, one-on-one pencil and paper memory testing and genetic swabbing for adults **aged 50-85** with memory concerns. Participants receive a private memory test (called the MoCA exam) and, if interested, a genetic swab.

There will be a sign-up sheet available at the reception desk (Pool desk) for anyone interested, starting Friday, November 16, 2018. Please direct any member of the public that would like to sign-up to the Pool reception desk. The sign-up sheet will be managed by the ISA working at the desk and **NOT** to be left on the counter unattended due to confidentiality issue.
